Dook Soup Recipe: (Approximately one meal)

- Carnivore Care[®] (Oxbow Pet Products) mix with low sodium chicken broth or water: approx 1 heaping tsp CC plus enough liquid to make it soupy
- 1 tsp Nutrical
- Pulverize/grind regular ferret food into a powder. 1 tsp powder plus enough water or broth to make it fluid – may need to soak for over an hour until it is lumpy chowder consistency
 - Add 1 tsp of this to the Carnivore Care soup
- 1 tsp baby food chicken or turkey, or cooked chicken puree
- Additional nutrients may be prescribed by the vet.
- Mix all of the above with enough additional broth or water to make it “soupy”
- The ferret may need encouragement to eat – often feeding off a finger or spoon may be needed to get one started. Can also do by syringe.
- Meal: usually 30 mLs of CC based food per 1 kg ferret at least 3 X a day – need to keep from losing weight.
